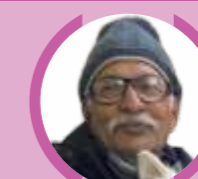

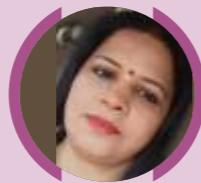

Key Areas of Focus

Educational Empowerment

We have provided access to quality education for underprivileged children, equipping them with the tools they need to break the cycle of poverty and build brighter futures.

Healthcare Initiatives

Our medical outreach programs have brought vital healthcare services to remote areas, improving the well-being of countless individuals and families.



Environmental Initiatives

Shibani foundation has shown a great concern toward green initiative as part of environmental mission. Massive plantation and environmental consciousness have been constantly adopted by the team.

Wellness, Relief & Distribution

Shibani Foundation has engaged the retired and senior citizens in lot of wellness activities for health and mental wellbeing. The team has given extensive wholehearted support to the victims of the flood affected areas near Greater Noida. The Foundation has distributed garments to several thousands of needy people in Greater Noida.

Our members reached to the families of labor class residing in Kasna area. These families are mainly of workers in the Kasna industrial area. On interaction, certain facts have emerged. Some of the important findings are:

- Large numbers of children's are not going to schools
- Team founded a lot of genuine reasons and constraints as to children are not interested in education. Few reasons are:
 - o Too many kids and elder, ones have to take care of small children when their parents are on work
 - o They have mobility of works
 - o Nearby schools have stringent criteria which they feel as burden
- Our Team motivated and brought children to EPIP centre for basic education and overall development
- Team arranged volunteers to take care of children and their development
- Children find it convenient to come to EPIP Centre between 10-12 noon on working days.

Open School:

- **Student Registration:** 120 students currently registered
- **Regular Attendance:** 35-40 students attend school regularly

Support for Underprivileged Children:

- **Stationery:** Provided to all attending students
- **Bags:** Distributed to support their educational needs
- **Books:** Ensuring access to necessary learning materials
- **Breakfast:** One nutritious breakfast provided daily
- **Sanitizer:** Regular supply to maintain hygiene and safety

These efforts collectively contribute to improving the quality of life and educational opportunities for underprivileged children, fostering a healthier, more educated community.

Success Stories

Sania, Sanjana, and Sofia are three students at Shibani Foundation Open School who have shown significant improvement in their studies from the very beginning. They joined the school about eight months ago. Their parents are daily wage workers in the nearby areas. Sania, Sanjana, and Sofia have regular attendance and are dedicated students. They have completed the basic courses at the primary level, including alphabets, words, sentences, and vocabulary in English, as well as var mala, shabdaravali, and barakhari in Hindi. In arithmetic, they have learned numericals, counting, and foundational knowledge. They have studied spoken words in both English and Hindi and have completed the curriculum for classes I, II, and III. They are capable of writing dictation in both languages. In arithmetic, they can solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division, as well as numerical for classes I, II, and III.

Additionally, they have actively participated in various drawing and sports competitions conducted by the school and have won several prizes.





Community Learning Centres: Centre offers literacy programs, vocational training, and digital literacy courses to underprivileged children and families.

Family Support Programs: Conduct educational workshops for families to encourage a supportive learning environment.

1. Educational Programs for Underprivileged Children:

- **Free Tutoring and Academic Support:** The foundation provides free tutoring sessions, helping children improve their academic performance and confidence.
- **Access to Learning Resources:** Children receive books, school supplies, and other essential educational materials.
- **Extracurricular Activities:** The foundation organizes extracurricular activities to promote holistic development, including sports, arts, and cultural programs.
- **Imparting Holistic Education:** The foundation endeavors not only to impart basic reading & writing skills but also focuses on imparting moral education and social etiquette for the holistic development of the children

2. Women's Education and Empowerment:

- **Skill Development Workshops:** Workshops focus on vocational training, digital literacy, and other skills to enhance employment opportunities for women.

Wellness activities

Engagement of Senior Citizens:

Flood Relief Activities:

- Team constantly visits the flood affected area in Yamuna near Sector 150, Noida.
- Several hundreds of houses were washed away, and people gathered on the roadside. People had a shortage of cloths, foods and other items.
- Team of Shibani foundation collected donation from residents of express Parkview-II, Chi-V, Greater Noida. The team prepared packets containing all essentials items like grocery and other. The team distributed the items to the victims of flood in the Sector 150, Noida.

Distribution:

- Team visited the labor colony in the area of Kasna, Knowledge Park III and Chi-V.
- The team collected several thousands of clothes, toys, cycles etc.
- The team distributed those items to needy people in those areas.
- Team also procured new items such as blankets, etc. and distributed to many families.
- Conducted Drives: 4-5 clothing drives held so far
- Distribution: New clothes distributed twice in the neighboring areas of Kasna

Target Group: Women and Adolescent girls

Objective: Teach basic stitching skills to foster self-reliance and enable them to earn their livelihood

Activities:

- Sewing classes led by experienced instructors of Design Department of Sharda University
- Provision of sewing machines and other resource

Expected Outcomes:

- Enhanced income-generating opportunities
- Increased confidence and self-sufficiency among participants

2. Shibani Foundation shall reach out to attract youth and women to provide computer training established by Sharda University in EPIP, Kasna.

Target Group: Adults and children

Objective: Equip participants with essential digital skills

Activities:

- Computer literacy classes covering basic operations and software
- Internet safety and digital communication workshops
- Access to computers and internet for practice and learning

Expected Outcomes:

- Improved job prospects for adults
- Enhanced academic performance and future readiness for children
- Greater digital inclusion and empowerment

3. Shibani Foundation will be strong partner in the Model Lab for Plumbing and Electrician Training.

Target Group: Community members interested in vocational training

Objective: Provide basic training in plumbing and electrical work

Activities:

- Hands-on training sessions conducted by certified professionals
- Workshops covering essential skills and safety practices
- Certification upon completion of the training program

Expected Outcomes:

- Creation of skilled tradespeople in the community
- Increased employability and income potential for participants
- Enhanced local infrastructure through community service projects
